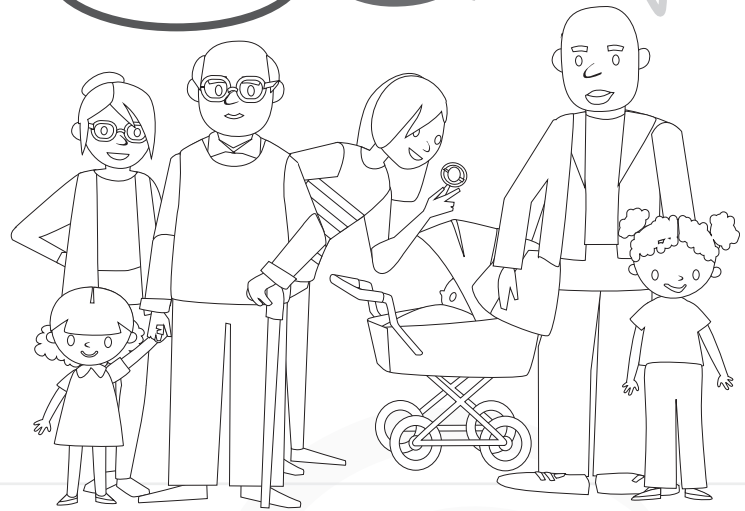


PRAYER GUIDE FOR EACH DAY OF MY PRAY-A-THON

 Saints Louis and Zélie Martin, *pray for us.*

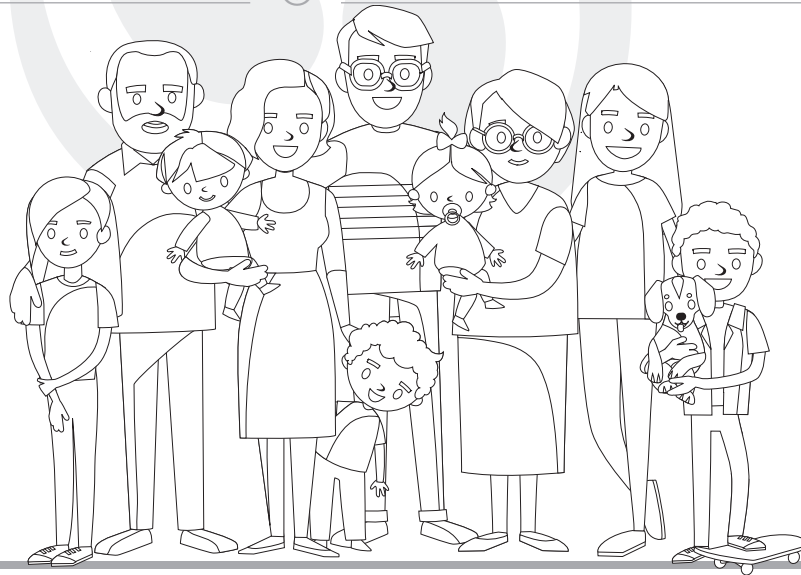
